Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) in Suffolk schools – Schools known to be affected by RAAC include East Bergholt HS, Hadleigh HS, Claydon HS, Farlingaye HS and Stowupland HS. (all academies). Affected areas are closed off and alternative arrangements being made. If further schools are identified these will be announced and steps taken ensure they are safe. Some schools have already had remedial work completed including Thurston Community College, Glade Academy and Newmarket Academy. The school building programmes was examined at the Educational and Childrens’ Services Scrutiny meeting on Thursday 7th October, including use of RAAC.

AURA Solar Farm – solar farm proposal mostly in Wortham and adjacent to the application by PACE:

Upgraded Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service Training Centre Opened at Wattisham – The centre now has a tactical firefighting facility built on a former cold war missile storage site which uses real fire, and an LPG-fired facility to simulate incidents firefighters may be faced with. The centre was formally declared open at the annual base families’ day on Thursday August 24 by Chief Fire Officer and Colonel Toby R Moore MBE, Station Commander, Wattisham Flying Station.

Norwich to Tilbury Pylon Line – The non-statutory consultation by National Grid is now closed, however discussions are ongoing concerning details of the route and areas that warrant undergrounding, particularly in the Upper Waveney Valley. Pylons Meeting in Wortham/ Royden – A meeting is planned at the Wortham Ling (Riverside House IP22 1SU) on Saturday 30th September at 10.00 am where there will be an opportunity to look at part of the Upper Waveney Valley that would be affected and discuss local options.

Electricity System Operator (ESO) Review – a review by ESO into electricity network coordination in East Anglia is delayed – refer to Open Letter in link below. This report will be relevant to plans for the Norwich to Tilbury transmission system and others in the region. In the meantime, National Grid is proceeding with its plans. Note that ESO is a legally separate organisation within the National Grid Group. In 2024, it will transition into the Independent System Operator and Planner – a new organisation which will be owned by

LionLink Interconnector Line may come to Walberswick – This National Grid Ventures project has identified a possible landfall at Walberswick, with cable routing north of Southwold. The non-statutory consultation on [National Grid Venture's LionLink project](#) will commence on the 8th September 2023 until 3rd November 2023. According to Cllr Rout, Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Finance and Environment: *"I'm deeply disappointed that National Grid has chosen to consider such a lengthy and complex cable route. Particularly given the Council's longstanding position that the array of projects coming forward in Suffolk should be properly coordinated"*

Major Planning/ Shepherd's Grove Stanton – Evolution's warehousing application DC/23/1154/OUT at Shepherd's Grove is live with a deadline for comments by 11th October. CoPart DC/22/1290/HYB is also live although the formal deadline for comments has passed. Both applications have major traffic implications for the area and local roads (A143, A14 and potentially the A140) as well as other potential impacts such as water use, contamination and fire risk.
